Since its formation in 2005, the Duo Fortin-Poirier has made it its mission to encourage the creation of new music for piano four hands by regularly collaborating with living composers and arrangers. The duo is also known for having developed the choreographic piano duet, a new technique inspired by synchronized swimming and dance.

Very active on the North American scene, the Duo Fortin-Poirier has distinguished itself in Canada and internationally, receiving grants, first prizes and awards (1st prize the Canadian Music Competition; 2nd Prize at the 2013 Concorso Pianistico Internazionale Roma; finalists at the 2009 Concours international de piano à quatre mains de Valberg and the 2011 Liszt 200 Chicago International Duo Piano Competition; Special Jury Mention at the 2010 International Edvard Grieg Piano Competition; and scholarships from the arts councils of Montreal, Québec and Canada).
